### Overview

MCK will display the Morse Code equivalent of all 26 letters. Currently, it does not show numbers or symbols. It represents dots with the asterisk (\*), and dashes with the dash (-). For a more complete Morse Code Listing, I recommend <<http://www.nosc.mil/w6rdf/morse.html>>.

### How to Run MCK

Use a shell or type `Asm(morse)` at the home screen. Press [ENTER] when finished.

### Compatibility

I have not tested MCK with any shells yet. It seems to work fine using "Asm(" from the home screen or a BASIC program.
