

The following applies to WINDOWS VISTA ONLY!

Prerequisite: TI-Connect

(or the icon "C:\Program Files\Common Files\TI Shared\Icons\Program32x32.ico")

This archive contains registry entries to create file-associations as follows:

Associate83.reg -- GraphLink 83 Plus; double-click to integrate it into the registry hive.

Associate *.8xp

Associate *.83p

Set default icon

Associate89.reg -- GraphLink 89; double-click to integrate it into the registry hive.

Associate *.89p

Set default icon

GraphLink.ico -- Icon file for start menu shortcuts; after saving it to your C:\ drive right-click the start menu shortcut and go to Properties > Change Icon and browse to the icon you just saved.

Known issues:

If you have tried to define a program association, this won't work right

Workaround:

1. Click "Start" and type "Regedit" and press [Enter]

2. Delete the key "UserChoice" from each of the following (if it exists)

HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\FileExts\.89P

HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\FileExts\.83P

HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Explorer\FileExts\.8XP

3. Close registry editor

4. Reboot

TI-83 Plus Editor gives errors as opening a file and/or opens multiple times

Workaround:

1. Click "Start" and type "Regedit" and press [Enter]

2. Navigate to

HKEY_CLASSES_ROOT\TI-83Plus.Program\shell\open\ddeexec

3. right-click the key "ddeexec" and choose "Permissions"

4. block permissions for every user (every entry) and click ok
