


I was fortunate to obtain a completely new TI-92+ in its opened package. So, I made a photograph while it had no dust particles, no fingerprints, and no scratches. Here it is converted into skins for various TI calculator emulators.

At this point in time (20220909), if you don't have an emulator, and don't have any ROM files, the simplest way to begin is by downloading and installing the "TiEmu" emulator. It is easy to find using Google. Then, go to the TI website, and download the latest operating system file for the Voyage 200. Set up TiEmu to emulate the V200, and use the "V200_as_TI-92+_Fresh_TiEmu.skn" skin file.

There is an advantage in using Rusty Wagner's older VTI emulator. If you have a ROM for the TI-92+ transferred from your personally owned TI-92+ calculator, you can use VTI to emulate it with a borderless skin. When you run it, all you will see is the calculator on your computer screen.



I made it big, with buttons that are easy to press, so if you have a laptop with a full HD (1920x1080) touch screen display, your experience will be exactly as if you are using a perfect TI-92+, freshly unboxed. This version will stay new and unscratched, forever.
